"CUENTOS DE PUTA MADRE" was performed for the first time in the anteroom of the IV Intercultural Oral Narration Festival of Seville. Since then, the stories have been presented successfully in various cultural theatres of Seville. When I created this performance, I wanted it to travel, I wanted the prostitute I play to leave the neighbourhood where she worked, and leave her corner with her street lamp, with the aim that her words become a vehicle in a dialogue which opens a door to reflection, as well as encouraging people not to forget the double taboo of sex and prostitution; this original desire still remains intact.

Let's go travel! Will you come with me?

Esther Yamuza is a narrator, an actress and a teacher. She collaborates with the Centre of Arts in Andalusia (Invigoration Reading Program), Danzamobile (Oral Expression Workshop and Narration), The Three Cultures of the Mediterranean Foundation (Activities for the Library), and The Museum of Fine Arts in Seville (Storyteller for the Family Program).
